Study Abroad Advice for BME Students

BME students who are interested in study abroad, typically pursue one of the following two options:

- study abroad during fall quarter of junior year
- study abroad with the Global Health Technologies Program in Cape Town, South Africa during the winter quarter of senior year

If you are interested in the Global Health Technologies Program, the key class you need to be concerned about is BME 378 Transport Fundamentals. BME 378 is a required course offered only during the winter quarter, so if you are considering this program, you should take BME 378 during the winter quarter of your junior year.
