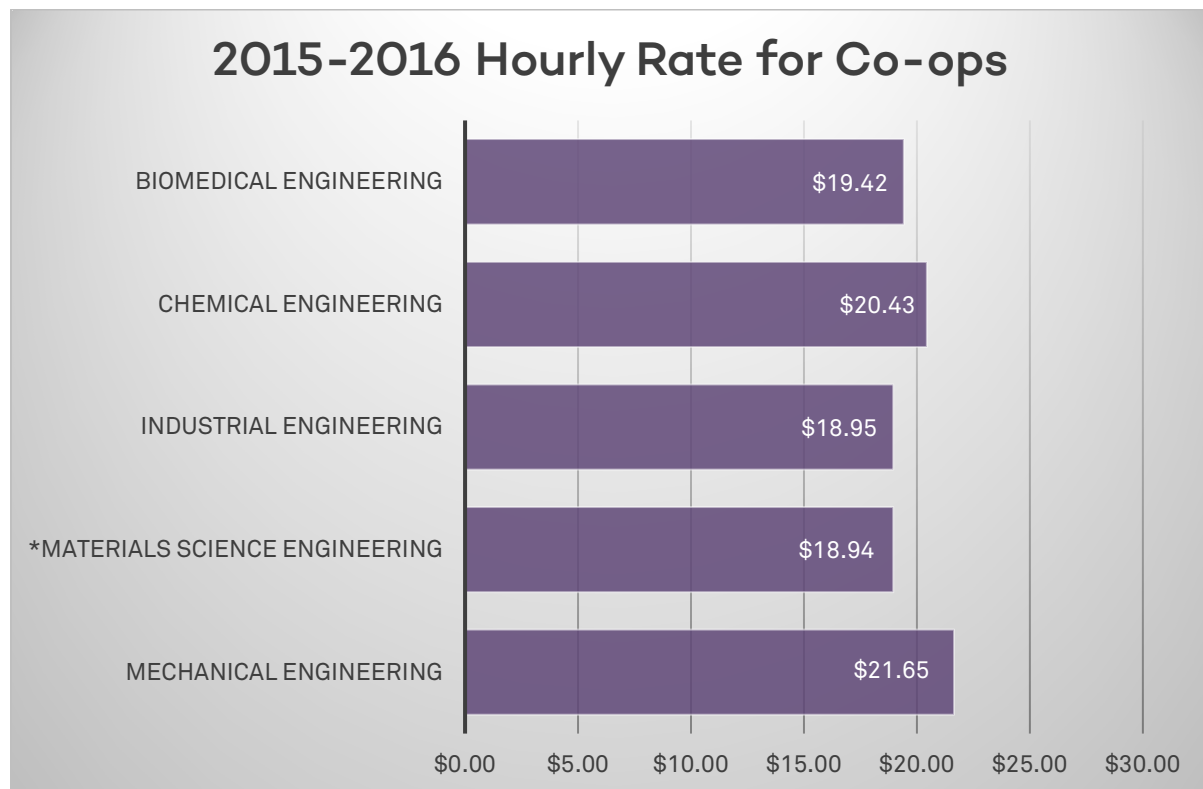


## Hourly Wages for McCormick Undergraduate Co-op Students 2015-2016

The average hourly wage for undergraduate co-op students studying across all disciplines within the McCormick School of Engineering and Applied Sciences is **\$20.07**, according to information that students self-report to the Engineering Career Development Office<sup>1</sup>. This is significantly higher than the 2016 National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) reported average hourly wage<sup>+</sup> paid to co-ops at the bachelor's degree level. NACE reports that across all disciplines in the US, co-ops are paid at a rate of \$16.97.

The hourly rate paid to McCormick students broken down by department can be found in the chart below. Please note that there are unrepresented major fields of study, due to a lack of self-reported student data.
