

Announcing the Dow Sustainability Innovation Student Challenge

The Dow Chemical Company Foundation is sponsoring one \$10,000 prize for Northwestern graduate students whose research addresses global sustainability challenges.

A Grand Prize (\$10,000) will be awarded to a **Northwestern graduate student or graduate student team** who are engaged in ongoing scientific, technical or social research to develop innovative, interdisciplinary approaches to meet human needs while also protecting the environment, promoting economic growth and achieving social welfare, now and into the future.* Eligible areas of research are:

- *sustainable chemistry
- *energy efficiency and conservation
- *reducing climate change impact
- *life cycle product safety
- *sustainable freshwater supply and distribution
- *environmental policy development and human behavior change
- *sustainable infrastructure
- *human health and the environment
- *breakthrough solutions to global sustainability challenges

Prize winners will be selected by Northwestern faculty on the basis of innovative thinking, excellence in research, the potential of the research to solve significant problems and the use of interdisciplinary approaches. Northwestern prize winners will join prize winners from 16 other universities around the world that are also part of the Dow Sustainability Innovation Student Challenge.
