BIOGRAPHY:

Matthias Ehrgott studied Mathematics, Economics and Computer Science at the University of Kaiserslautern in Germany where he obtained Masters (1992), PhD (1997) and Habilitation (2001) degrees. In 2000 he moved to the Department of Engineering Science at the University of Auckland, New Zealand, as a lecturer and became full Professor in 2011. Currently he is Professor and Head of the Management Science Department at Lancaster University Management School in the UK. Matthias' research interest is in multi-objective optimisation, which he applies in a variety of areas such as medicine, transportation, and manufacturing. He has published about 80 journal papers, book chapters and proceedings contributions on theory, methodology, and applications of multi-objective optimisation. In addition he has authored and edited about 30 books, proceedings volumes and special issues of journals on the topic. The book "Multicriteria Optimization" (Springer, 2005) is a standard monograph in the field. In total his work has been cited nearly 10,000 times (Google Scholar). He serves on the editorial board of 10 journals, including Computers & OR, and Journal of Global Optimization. Since 2002 he has been on the Executive Committee of the International Society on Multiple Criteria Decision Making, where he is the current president elect. In 2011 he received the Edgeworth-Pareto award of that Society. He organized the 19th International MCDM Conference in 2008 and was on the programme committee of many other international conferences.
